

Outlook Express Email Client Setup for Windows XP

Open Outlook Express by clicking the Start button, All Programs, and finding Outlook Express in the Programs list.

Click Tools and select Accounts from the drop-down menu, see Fig.1.



Click Add > Mail... see Fig. 2.



Type in your name as you would prefer people to see it in the from field when they receive your email and click next, see Fig. 3.



Type in your WildBlue email address and click next. Fig. 4.



Select POP3 from the incoming mail server type dropdown
Incoming mail server is: pop.wbaccess.net
Outgoing mail server is: mail.wbaccess.net
Click next, see Fig. 5.




Click Finish, see Fig. 7.





Click the servers tab, see Fig. 9.



Check the box that says My Server requires authentication and click OK, see Fig. 10.



Close the Internet Accounts window, see Fig. 11.


